Curtainside trailers

Curtainside (or tautliner) trailers have a hard-shell roof, solid front bulkhead, conventional rear doors and retractable curtains on the sides. The three-sided access allows for quicker cargo loading and unloading.

Details at a glance

Protection: Efficient loading and unloading: Lift trucks can easily load and unload cargo from both sides and the back of the trailer, speeding up operational processes.

Flexible for partial deliveries: The trailer offers access to any part of the cargo during unloading eliminating the need to load items in a specific sequence.
