

Trailer types and sizes

Tarpaulin trailers

With an open body and frame covered by a tarp, these trailers are most commonly used for transporting goods that require protection from the elements but not a hermetic trailer.

Details at a glance

Weather protection: The tarp cover provides excellent rain, wind and UV protection.
